Code of conduct for KASC library users

The purpose of the academic library is to support the curriculum, research and personal development of the members of the academic community, and to provide a quiet place to work or study. Kongu Arts and Science College Library is open to all its students, faculty and staff of the college. It offers essential resources for students to access the information sources they need to excel in their academic efforts, in their day-to-day lives and in their decision-making activities.

All users of the Library of Kongu Arts and Science College are subject to the following Code of conduct to use the facilities or materials.

- 1. No loud conversation or group discussion are allowed in the Library.
- No radio, tapes players, walkman, cellular phones, etc., are to be used in the Library.

- 3. Laptop computers, if used in the Library, must have get permission from the library staff.
- 4. No food or drink is allowed in the Library. Trash is deposited in proper receptacles.
- 5. No smoking is permitted.
- 6. Borrowing materials without a valid student ID card is prohibited, no one is permitted to use another person's ID card to borrow materials.
- 7. Disruptive behaviour will not be tolerated in the Library.
- The Library is not responsible for any personal items left in the Library. The library users are requested to take their personal belongings with them when leaving the Library.
- 9. Do not re-shelve books, periodicals etc.,
- 10. Each member is responsible for all charges and fines on his/her record.
- 11. Use of workstation Policy

Use of library public workstations will be limited to 30 minutes sessions. Whenever patrons are waiting to use workstations, the 30 minute per session limit will have to be strictly enforced with a sign-up list. Patrons who have already had access to workstations for 30 minutes or more may be required to relinquish them to those who are next on the sign-up list. Workstations are assigned on a first come, first served basis.

12. Complaint Procedure

All complaints must be written, signed and addressed to the Librarian. Whenever the Librarian deems it necessary, he will refer the matter to appropriate College Administrators.

13. Patron IDs:

In order to use the Library, patrons are required to have current KASC student or staff ID. Although it is necessary to show an ID to enter the Library, students and other patrons are required to present their ID card to library personnel upon request. Likewise, library staff members have the right to ask Security Personnel for assistance with students and other patrons who refuse to comply with the library Code of Conduct or any other rules and regulations of the Library.

Library Borrowing Privileges and Responsibilities:

1. ID Cards:

In order to borrow library materials, library users must present a current validated ID card. They records must be renewed at the beginning of each semester by presenting a validated ID card or proof of registration.

2. Periodicals:

Newspapers, Periodicals (journals and magazines) and reference materials do not circulate. They may not be borrowed and must be used within the Library.

3. Reservation of Materials:

The users can reserve the materials when it is on transaction. They can inform after return the material for and issue will be made tom the reservation users.

4. Renewals:

Renewals may be done in person or with the book(s) presented for renewal. Items may be renewed one time only for 15 days for UG and 2 renewals for PG and research scholars.

5. Loan Periods:

Regular circulating items may be borrowed for 15 days and may be renewed one time for 15 days for UG and two times for PG and research scholars

6. All the books are due and must be returned four days before the closure of each semester,

7. Fine: If a book is not returned by the due date a fine of Re.1/- per day will be levied.

8. Lost Items:

In case a borrowed book is lost, the latest price of the book will be collected from the defaulter along with other charges if any.

9. Clearance:

Clearances will not be granted until any all outstanding fines or delinquent accounts have been settled to the satisfaction of the Library. Failures to obtain a Library Clearance will delay the receipt of refunds, letters, and transcripts until such clearances are obtained.

10. On-line Access:

Users can access online Journals and E-books and other e-resources through NLIST Programme. Nearly 1200 Journals and 52,000 e-books can access by providing user ID and password will be given to the each users. They can access the e-resources in any places at anytime. The National Digital Library provide 6 crores e- resources our college passkey id in any place at anytime.

11. Obtaining Books and Articles from other Libraries:

An Inter-Library Loan (ILL) request must be in order to borrow books or obtain articles from other Libraries like British Council Library, Kongu Engineering College Library, Erode College of Pharmacy. Inter-Library loan is currently available to staff and students for reference the materials within the Library.

Barcode Number and PIN

Each registered library user has a barcode attached in the front of their ID cards, and in automatically assigned a Roll Number. Call the library staff at the Circulation Desk in the Library if you have forgotten or do not know your Roll Number.
