

#### **CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM**

The Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) is a student – centric approach for learning. It enables the students a good flexibility to meet the inter-disciplinary and intra-disciplinary needs. In CBCS, the students obtain the privilege of choosing the subjects of their own choice and it provides marks in grading system. The CBCS makes the students to acquire job-oriented and multi-disciplinary skills.

#### **OUTCOME BASED EDUCATION (OBE)**

OBE has been adopted in the curriculum and the evaluation system. OBE is meant to be student cantered learning model. The focus on outcome create a clear expectation of what needs to be accomplished by the end of the course. Students will know their expectation and teachers will know what they need to teach during the course. The Knowledge, Skill and Attitude of the students will be improved and the quality of the education will also be enhanced through OBE.

#### **UNDER GRADUATE PROGRAMME**

The Programme shall lead to the Degree of Bachelor of Arts / Science / Computer Applications / Commerce / Business Administration under Bharathiar University, Coimbatore and spread over a period of 3 years. The 3 academic years will be divided into 6 semesters with 2 semesters per year.







## STRUCTURE OF THE PROGRAMME UNDER GRADUATE

#### Part-I: Tamil / Malayalam / Hindi / French / Sankrit

All UG Programmes shall offer Part-I during the first Four Semesters with one Examination at the end of each semester (4 Courses - 16 Credits).

#### Part II: English

All UG Programmes shall offer Part-II English during the first Four Semesters with one Examination at the end of each semester (4 Courses - 16 Credits).

# Part-III (i) Core Courses

As prescribed in the Scheme of Examination, 16 to 17 Courses with 64 - 71 Credits shall be offered. Semester Examinations shall be conducted at the end of every semester.

#### (ii) Allied Courses

As prescribed in the Scheme of Examination, 4 Courses in I, II, III and IV semesters for a total of 16 Credits shall be offered.

#### (iii) Elective Courses

Three Elective Courses with 12 Credits shall be offered, one in the V semester and two in the VI semester. Elective Courses are to be selected from the list of Electives prescribed by the Board of Studies concerned.







#### (iv) Project

The aim of giving Project Work is to impart practical knowledge to implement the concepts learned. The Head of the Department of the Programme concerned shall assign a Project Supervisor. Each student should carry out individually one Project Work. The Project Report should be submitted at the end of the Course of the study certified by the Supervisor and duly countersigned by the Head of the Department.

#### (v) Institutional / Industrial Training

Institutional / Industrial Training are a Specialized Field Training Programme required to be attached to an Industry / Institution as inhouse training for a period prescribed by the Board of Studies concerned. At the end of the Training Programmes, each student should submit a Report for End Semester Examinations.

#### Part - IV (i) Environmental Studies

All the UG Programmes shall offer a course in "Environmental Studies" and it shall be offered in the First Semester. Examination shall be conducted at the end of the Semester with 2 Credits.

#### (ii) Value Education

All the UG Programmes shall offer a course in "Value Education". It shall be offered in the Second Semester. Examination shall be conducted at the end of the Semester with 2 Credits.

#### (iii) Non Major Electives

A. Students those who have not studied Tamil upto 12th standard and taken a Non-Tamil Language under Part-I shall take Basic Tamil comprising of 2 Courses with 2 Credits each (4 Credits) in the Third and Fourth Semesters. The course contents equivalent to the prescribed content for 6th standard by the Board of Secondary Education shall be offered. There shall be no End Semester Examinations and the students shall be assessed as per the Scheme of Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) for the total marks prescribed.

B. Those who have studied Tamil upto 12th standard and have chosen a Non-Tamil Language under Part-I shall take Advanced Tamil comprising of 2 Courses with 2 Credits each (4 Credits) in the Third and Fourth Semesters.

(0R)

C. Others who do not come in the above A & B categories can choose the Non- Major Electives comprising of 2 Courses with 2 Credits each (4 Credits) in the Third and Fourth Semesters. The students shall not take the course offered by their Department and select any one Course offered by other Departments. The assessment for the category in B & C Courses shall be through End Semester Examination (ESE) for the total marks prescribed. There shall be no Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA).

#### (iv) Skill Based Courses

All the UG Programmes shall offer 4 Skill Based Courses, one in III, IV, V & VI Semesters with 3 Credits each (12 Credits) for which Examination shall be conducted at the end of the respective Semesters.

#### (v) Self Learning

All UG programmes shall offer a self-learning course "Gender Studies," in the third semester and "Fundamentals of Yoga," in the fourth semester. Examinations for these courses will be conducted at the end of the respective semesters, with each course carrying 2 credits.



#### Part - V Extension Activities

Under Graduate students shall enroll in any one of the Extension Activities (NCC / NSS / YRC / RRC / Sports / Clubs / Forums) during the first two years. Students' performance will be examined by the staff incharge of Extension Activities along with the Head of the respective Department and a senior member of the Department on the following parameters.

- 10 marks for Regularity of Attendance
- 20 marks for Active Participation in Classes / Camps / Sports & Games / Special Camps / Programs in College / University / District / State
- 10 marks for Exemplary Awards / Certificates / Prizes
- 10 marks for other social components such as Blood Donation and Fine Arts

The marks shall be sent to the Controller of Examinations before the Commencement of the Final Semester Examination.

#### Advanced Learners Courses (ALC)

Students are offered two Advanced Learners Courses that are optional and purely self study Courses. These Courses are offered to the students those who have secured 7.5 and above CGPA upto the respective Semesters (III & IV) in Part III only for UG Science and 7.0 and above CGPA for UG Arts students. The students can choose any one of the Courses offered. Exam will be conducted only in their End Semester Examination (ESE). The students can earn 2 Extra Credits for each ALC and the marks obtained in ALC will not be considered for computation of CGPA. The students who have no standing arrear are eligible to choose ALC, if they got failed in ALC (IV Semester) are not eligible to reappear and choose the ALC in the succeeding Semester (V Semester).

#### **Extra Credits**

There is a provision for Extra Credits for NCC cadets (2 credits for B certificate students and 2 credits for C certificate Exam appeared students) for the students admitted during the academic year 2021-2022 and onwards

#### **POST GRADUATE PROGRAMME**

- ▼ The Programme shall lead to the Degree of Master of Arts / Science / Commerce / Management Science (MBA) / Computer Application under Bharathiar University, Coimbatore and spread over a period of 2 years. The academic year will be divided into 2 Semesters per year.
- ➤ Each Semester normally consists of 90 working days with 5 hours per day. However, the working days may exceed 90 days, depending on the circumstances.

#### **Advanced Learners Courses (ALC)**

Students are offered one Advanced Learners Course which is optional and purely a Self Study Course. This course is offered to students who have secured a 7.0 and above CGPA up to II Semester. The students can choose any one of the Courses offered, Exam will be conducted during their End Semester Examination (ESE) in the III Semester. The students can earn 2 Extra Credits for each ALC and the marks obtained in ALC will not be considered for computation of CGPA. The students who have no standing arrear are eligible to choose ALC







#### **Structure of the Programme**

- Every Programme comprises both theory and practical courses in each semester as detailed in the respective curricula and syllabi approved by the Board of Studies and Academic Council of the College.
- Elective Courses are to be selected from the List of Electives prescribed by the Board of Studies concerned.
- All the PG Students who have been admitted during the academic year 2021-2022 and onwards are provided with the implementation of NPTEL/ SWAYAM for equivalent Elective courses offered in IV Semester for PG students.
- Comprehensive examinations will be offered in the third semester. These
  examinations, worth 2 credits, will be conducted at the end of the
  semester.

#### **Project**

The aim of giving Project Work is to impart practical knowledge to implement the concerned shall assign a Project Supervisor. Each student should carry out individually one Project Work. The Project Report should be submitted at the end of the Course of the study and certified by the Supervisor and duly countersigned by the Head of the Department.

#### **Institutional / Industrial Training**

Institutional / Industrial Training is a specialized field training programme required to be attached to an Institution / Industry as in-house training for a period prescribed by the Board of Studies concerned. At the end of the training programme, each student should submit a report to the Department concerned for evaluation.







## RULES AND REGULATIONS

#### **Admission**

The candidates for UG and PG Programmes shall be admitted as per the norms prescribed by the Bharathiar University, Coimbatore and as per the regulations specified by the Government of Tamil Nadu.

#### **Fees**

Candidates selected at the interview shall remit the fees immediately. The second & third-year students shall pay the fees within 15 days after the reopening of the College. If a student fails to pay fees on the due date, a fine will be imposed. If the fee is not paid within a month, the student's name will be removed from the roll. If re-admitted, the student should pay re-admission fees in addition to the fine due.

#### **Attendance Requirements**

Students should not be absent from the College without valid reasons. In case of leave for genuine reasons, a leave letter should be submitted to the Head of the Department concerned, In case of absence without prior permission, the leave letter should be submitted on the first day of his/her return to the College. The medical certificate should accompany the leave application in case of leave due to sickness for more than 3 days. If a student is absent for an hour in a session, without getting permission from the staff concerned he/ she will be considered absent for that session.







#### **EXAMINATIONS & ATTENDANCE**

#### Proforma I

Shall contain the list of candidates who have earned **75% of attendance and above** in the current semester and who are eligible to write the examinations.

#### Proforma II

Shall contain the list of candidates who have earned attendance between 65% and 74% (both included) in the current semester.

#### Proforma III

Shall contain the list of all candidates who have earned attendance between 55% and 64% (both included) in the current semester. Such candidates are not eligible to write the examination in current semester courses but are permitted to continue their studies in their next semester provided that it is the first time that the candidates' earned attendance is between 55% and 64% or else the candidates have to discontinue the course and re-join in the same semester in the next year with proper approval of the Registrar of Bharathiar University. However, these candidates are eligible to write arrear subjects, if any.

#### Proforma IV

Shall contain the list of candidates who have earned **Attendance of 54%** and below. They are not eligible to write their examination in current semester courses and also have to discontinue the Programme and rejoin in the same semester in the next year with proper approval of the Registrar of Bharathiar University. These candidates are eligible to write arrear subjects, if any.

#### Proforma V

Shall contain the list of candidates who have earned attendance between **55 % and 64%** in the previous semester and earned combined attendance of 75% or more by taking the average of the attendance earned combined with current and previous semesters. These candidates are eligible to write previous courses along with the current semester courses.





#### Proforma VI

Shall contain the list of candidates who have earned attendance **between 55% to 64 % in the previous semester and earned combined attendance between 65 % and 75%** by taking the average of the attendance earned in current and previous semesters. Such candidates are eligible for condonation of shortage of attendance by the Principal by paying the CONDONATION FEE and are eligible to write previous semester courses along with the current semester courses.

#### Proforma VII

Shall contain the list of candidates who have earned attendance between 55% to 64 % in the previous semester and earned combined attendance between 64 % and below by taking the average of the attendance earned in the current and previous semesters. Such candidates are not eligible to write the examination of previous and current semester courses and shall discontinue the programme and rejoin to continue the previous semester of study in the next academic year with proper approval from the Registrar of Bharathiar University. However, these candidates are eligible to write arrear courses, if any.

#### Proforma VIII

Shall contain the list of candidates who are eligible to appear for current Semester courses i.e. whose names are given in proforma I/II/V/VI but who have not paid exam fees and have not registered for current semester courses.







#### **LIBRARY**

- All Faculty and Students of the college are members of the library.
- UG students will be issued two library books, and PG students will receive five library books.
- All library facilities, supported by expert assistance, are available to students and faculty on all working days.
- The library has 37,481 books, 123 journals, and access to 243,276 e-resources for students, research scholars and faculty members.
- An ID card is mandatory for logging in and out of the library.
- Borrowed books must be returned on or before the due date.
- An ID card is required for all transactions. Books shall not be issued to holders using another person's ID card.
- All books must be returned to the library four days before each semester's closure.
- The library is computerized using ERP automation software, which helps Students and Staff members search for any type of library document.
- Bar-coding technology has been adopted with the software to speedup the circulation process.
- Institutional Memberships include INFLIBNET (N-LIST), DELNET, the British Council of India, NDLI (National Digital Library of India) and Knimbus Library Portal (remote access).
- Reference books, journals, back volumes, project reports shall not be issued to members.
- A Photocopier is available in the library, providing reprographic services to users at a nominal cost, along with round -the- clock internet access.
- The library is equipped with 15 CCTV surveillance cameras for proper vigilance of the library holdings and to prevent misbehavior such as misplacement or tearing by users.
- Silence must be maintained inside the library at all times.





#### **CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOUR**



- Students must conduct themselves in such a way as not to bring discredit to the College or to themselves. They should be refined in behaviour and should show due respect to the authority.
- Students are expected to be neat, clean and simple in their dress.
   They must confirm to the standards of modesty maintained by the Institution.
- The girls should wear only Chudidar / Saree (not to wear leggings or short tops or sleeves) black cut shoes and the boys should wear only Full pant and formal Shirt (Half-Sleeve / Full-Sleeve) with black formal shoes. They should not wear shirts bearing pictures and printed matters. T-Shirts and casual / Sportive Jeans (Multi-Pockets with stripes in fading colour) are totally banned inside the campus. Boys should be in clean shave and short formal haircut.
- Identity Card will be issued to the students soon after the admission and it should be produced on demand. Students should wear the identity Card at all the time inside the campus. Students who lost their ID Cards shall make a written request to the principal for a duplicate Identity Card.
- Students should be punctual to the classes. A student shall not enter or leave the class without the permission of the staff.
- Strict silence should be observed during the class hours and inside the College premises.
- Students should acquaint themselves with the notification put on the College Notice Board, regularly. Excuses will not be given on failing to comply with it.







- Students are forbidden from organizing meetings in the College or collecting money for any purpose. Books, Magazines and other materials that are not approved by the principal will not be permitted in the College premises.
- Students are expected to take proper care of the College property and they should help in keeping premises neat and clean.
   Disfiguring the walls and doors or breaking the furniture is a breach of discipline and will be severely punished.
- Students who come to college by own vehicle should hold a valid driving license along with other necessary documents and helmet.
- Using Mobile phone inside the College Campus is not allowed.
- Breach of any of the above rules will lead to disciplinary action resulting even in expulsion.
- In case, any criminal case is registered against a student by the law enforcing authorities, he/she should intimate the same within 24 hours to the principal.
- a) Under Tamil Nadu Educational rules, the Principal has authority to give the following punishments to bring about constructive change among the students: i) Fines ii) Loss of attendance iii) Loss of term certificate iv) Suspension v) Expulsion.
  - b) The Head of the Institution has the power to take disciplinary action against an erring student.







#### **PROHIBITION OF RAGGING**

The Government of Tamilnadu has passed an Act prohibiting Ragging. Act. No. 7 of Prohibition of Ragging Act 1997 curtails ragging. As per the Act, Ragging within or outside the Education Institution is prohibited.

Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in abets or propagates "Ragging", within or outside the Educational Institution, shall be punished with imprisonment for a term which extends to two years and shall also be liable to a fine which may extend to Rs. 10,000/-

Any student convicted of an offence under Section 4 shall also be dismissed from the Educational Institution and such student will not be admitted in any other Educational Institutions. By the very fact of joining the college, students agree to observe the rules and regulations of the college.

The decision of the Principal will be the final in all matters of discipline and enforcement of rules. Depending upon the nature of the offence as established by the Anti – Ragging Curb Committee of the College, the punishments for those who found to be guilty of ragging shall be Suspended/Debarred.




