MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

OF "THE KONGU VELLALAR INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY TRUST" ERODE.

1. The name of the Society is "THE KONGU VELLALAR INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY TRUST", ERODE, and the name is hereinafter referred to be the Trust.
2. The registered Office of the Trust is situated at 47-A, Park Road, Erode. It is to be shifted to College building soon after construction.
3. The objects for which the Trust is established are:-
 - a) to purchase land, build college of Technology, workshops for teaching and hostel and other movables necessary for teaching the students;
 - b) to promote cultural activities and scientific knowledge through the Kongu Vellalar Institute of Technology Trust, Erode;
 - c) to enter into any agreement with or apply for and accept from any Government or authorities Local, Municipal or otherwise any rights, privileges and concessions which the Trust may think desirable to obtain;

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d) to establish, organise and conduct hostels, canteen, transport facilities etc., for the students of the College of Technology run by this Trust.

e) to collect donations from individuals and associations for improving the institution "The Kongu Vellalar Institute of Technology Trust", Erode.

4. The income and property of the Trust whenever derived shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Trust as set forth in the Memorandum of Association and no portion shall be paid or transferred to the members of the Trust.

5. Any surplus funds of the Trust shall be invested in the manner as laid down under section 13(5) of the Income-tax Act, 1961.

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THE KONGU VELLALAR INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY TRUST, ERODE.
RULES AND REGULATIONS.

1. The name of the Society is " THE KONGU VELLALAR INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY TRUST " and the name is hereinafter referred to as " TRUST ".
2. The address of the registered Office of the Society is Door No. 47-A, Park Road, Erode.
3. The date of formation of the Society is 9.3.1983.
4. This Society is situated within the Jurisdiction of the Registrar of Periyar District, Erode.
5. The business hours of the Society shall be 10 A.M. to 1 P.M. and 3 P.M. to 4 P.M. on all week days except Sundays and Government Holidays.
6. a) The objects of the Trust are to run, administer and improve the institution " THE KONGU VELLALAR INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY TRUST " ERODE.
b) To construct a building of college of Technology and Workshop in the land purchased by the Trust, for the students of " The KONGU VELLALAR INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY TRUST " ERODE.

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c) To encourage, provide and promote literary and scientific knowledge through College of Technology, to be established under "THE KONGU VELLALAR INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY TRUST, PERODE.

7. All proceedings before any court or other Tribunals shall be represented by the Secretary and he shall be the person to sue or to be sued on behalf of the Trust.

8. ENROLMENT OF MEMBERS:

There shall be 2 classes of members.

i) Patrons

ii) Life members.

PATRONS:

Any person of sound mind and above 21 years, belonging to the Kongu Vellalar Community who contributes by way of donations by his own self and/or through his friends and relations, a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- and above shall be eligible for membership. The said donation of Rs.1,00,000/- can be made in the said manner by the said donor member on or before 31st December, 1985.

If the donor member having contributed a part of the said sum of Rs.1,00,000/- and failed to contribute the balance on or before 31.12.1985 he shall cease to be a member. Those who contribute Rs.1,00,000/- and more as above said, shall be patron member and shall be eligible to become members of the Executive Committee of the Trust.

LIFE MEMBERS:

Any person of sound mind and above 21 years, belonging to the Kongu Vellalar Community who contributes by way of donations by his own self and/or through his friends and relatives a sum of Rs.50,000/- shall be eligible for Life membership. The said donation of Rs.50,000/- can be made in the said manner by the donor member on or before 31st December, 1985.

If the donor member having contributed a part of the said sum of Rs.50,000/- and failed to contribute the balance on or before 31.12.1985 he shall cease to be member.

9. RIGHTS, OBLIGATIONS AND PRIVILEGES OF MEMBERS OF TRUST:

The members of the Trust shall have the right to participate in General Meetings and also to call for General Meetings.

Every member shall whole-heartedly work for the improvement and welfare of the Trust. Patron members are exempt from paying their annual subscriptions to the Trust. The life member shall pay an annual subscription.

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of Rs.10/-to the Trust.

Every member of the Trust shall have the privilege to receive in writing calling for a General Meeting with the Agenda not less than 21 days before the date of such meeting. Such notices shall be served person, or through post or through press.

Every patron member is to be ~~and~~ elected for the Executive Committee in 3 years. On the death of a patron member, the executive committee shall have the option to admit one of his male legal heirs to be the patron member without the obligation to donate a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- Among life members 1/5th of them shall be elected from among themselves to the executive committee. Such members are to be elected for the First Executive Committee. The first election for the executive Committee shall be held in June, 1985. The life members who are so elected to the executive committee do not have the right to contest for the election of the offices of the President, Vice-Presidents, Secretary, Assistant secretary's, and Treasurer. The patron members who are the executive committee members also, shall alone have the right to contest for any Office. An extra-ordinary meeting of the Trust may be convened by the President, Secretary, or on a requisition of patron members stating the object for which the meeting is to be called for within 25 days of the receipt of such requisition, the secretary shall convene such meeting.

The patron members who constitute the Executive Committee with majority can call for amendment of the bye-laws for enrolling members of other categories.

Any person of sound mind and above the age of 21 years of Kong Vellalar Community, desires to become a member of the Trust after 31.12.1985, shall be admitted as a patron if he pays Rs.2,00,000/- as donation at the time of his admission in the Trust as a patron member. Any member who pays Rs.1,00,000/- after 31.12.1985 shall be admitted as Life member. Any member of the Trust, if found to be working against the Trust shall be removed from the membership with three fourth of the members of the Executive Committee present in such meeting voting; such removal such a decision shall be final.

11. The Secretary of the Trust shall prepare such records, annual or other statements which are specified in the Tamil Nadu Societies Registration Act, 1975 and the Rules made thereunder and file them before the concerned Registrar.

12. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF PRESIDENT AND OFFICE BEARERS:

PRESIDENT:

The President is the Head of the ^{Trust} and shall preside over all meetings. He shall have the power to supervise and control the activities of the Officers of the Trust. The documents and other records shall be under the control of the President. In case of equality of votes, the President shall have a casting vote in addition to his vote. The President shall sign the Minutes of each of the meetings.

VICE-PRESIDENTS:

In the absence of the President, the senior among the Vice Presidents shall preside over such meetings and shall also have such powers in a meeting as the President has.

SECRETARY:

The Secretary shall, with the approval of the Executive Committee, call for the Annual General Body meeting every year in the month of

The Secretary shall carry out the resolutions passed by the Executive Committee and General body meetings from time to time.

The Secretary shall manage the affairs of the Trust under the control of the Executive committee.

The Secretary shall have full control over the establishment of the Trust and to look after the day-to-day affairs of the Trust.

The Secretary shall do all acts which are considered necessary for the betterment of Trust.

The Secretary shall lay before each Annual General Body Meeting a receipt and expenditure account and the audited Balance sheet for the financial year of the Trust which is 1st April to 31st March of each

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The Secretary shall maintain Minutes of all proceedings of every Annual General Body meeting, General Meeting and executive committee meeting.

The Secretary shall be the custodian of all the properties of the Trust movable and immovables.

The Secretary shall carry on the correspondence on behalf of the Trust. He shall have power to take disciplinary action against the members of the staff and servants.

The Secretary shall have power to borrow and spend the funds to such limit for the furtherance of the objects of Trust, as may be fixed by the Executive Committee from time to time and subject to the consent and ratification of the Executive committee and for purposes of securing loans from Bank and financial institutions, is further authorised to create charges over the properties and assets of the Trust, whenever it is necessary subject to ratification by the executive committee, He is also empowered to give the Trust properties as security to the State Government if Government notifications require.

JOINT SECRETARY:

In the absence of secretary, the Joint Secretary, the Joint Secretary/ Secretaries shall have the power to attend to the day-to-day work of the Secretary.

TREASURER:

The Treasurer shall keep proper books of accounts with respect to all sums of money received and expended by the Trust, He is entitled to keep up to Rs.5,000/- in cash in hand and shall deposit the balance in a Bank decided upon by the Executive Committee. He shall operate the Bank account jointly with the Secretary.

13. a) The property, both movables and immovables of the Trust shall be under the custody of the Secretary.

b) The income and property of the Trust whenever derived shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Trust as set forth in the Memorandum of Association and no portion shall be paid or transferred to the members of the Trust.

Any surplus funds of the Trust shall be invested in the manner as laid down under section 13(5) of the Income tax Act, 1961.

14. (a) The Trust may carry such activity which may be required in furtherance of its objects.

b) The trust shall transact its business to the objects as envisaged in the Memorandum of Association, confining to the Rules and Regulation of the Trust.

15. This being a Trust established for the purpose of running an educational institution shall not earmark any of its funds for making provision for a dependent of deceased member or a disabled member.

16. The Secretary is the person empowered to give directions in regard to the business of the Trust.

17. The General Body meeting of the Trust shall be called by the Secretary once in a year in the month of June and the meeting shall be called Annual General Body Meeting. An extra-ordinary meeting of the Trust may

be convened at any time by the President, Secretary, or any member of the Executive Committee and shall be convened by them on receipt of

requisition in writing signed by one tenth of the total members of the Body of the Trust stating by which the meeting is to be called for

25 days of the receipt of the said requisition, the Secretary shall convene the same and in default, the requisitionists themselves may

convene the ~~same and in default~~ meeting. Notice of all General Meeting and agenda shall be given in writing not less than 21 days

the date of the meeting by the Secretary to each member of the Trust either in person or by post or publication in the Press. The quorum

the general meeting shall be nine. *five*

18. ACCOUNTS:

(1) The financial year of the Trust shall be from 1st April to 31st March of every year. The Accounts of the Trust shall be audited by

Chartered Accountant appointed by the Executive Committee. The accounts shall be placed before the Annual General meeting for approval.

The following documents shall be filed with the Registrar of Societies within one month from the date of the holding of the Annual General meeting.

a) An authenticated copy of such receipts and expenditure account balance sheet and report;

b) A statement of the names, addresses and occupations of the members who at the expiry of the financial year were members of the registered Society.

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e.) A declaration to the effect that the society has been carrying on its operation during the financial year.

2) A statement as to the change if any, of the Registered Office of the Trust, a statement of the change among the members and Office bearers of the executive committee of the trust and that of members and a statement of mortgage or charge created by the trust over the assets of the trust within the time stipulated under the Act.

19. If upon the dissolution of the trust there shall remain after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities any property whatsoever, the same shall not be sold to or distributed among the members of the Trust but shall be handed over to an Association of person having similar Objects to be determined by votes of not less than 3/4th of the members present at the meeting called for the dissolution of the trust.

20. The Trust shall on requisition made in writing by any member of the Trust and on payment of Rs.1/- shall supply a copy of byelaws.

A member shall be served a copy of receipt and payment's account, income and expenditure account and balance sheet along with the notices calling the Annual General Meeting.

21. Any member of the Trust or any Officer of the trust violating any of the provisions contained in by byelaws shall be levied a fine of Rs.50/- which may be revised from time to time by the Executive Committee. However this shall not stand in the way of the trust proceeding against such member or an Officer in any court of Law for infringing any of the provisions said above and thereby causing damage either to the name of the trust or to the property of it.

Further, every Officer of the trust shall be indemnified out of the trust against any liability incurred by him in defending any proceedings, whether civil or criminal, in which judgement is given in his favour or in ~~his favour~~ which he is acquitted.

22. The Trust shall pass special resolutions wherever it is provided under the Act such as in the case of amalgamation and division of the Trust and winding up of the Trust and for amending the byelaws of the trust.

23. The books of account, the minutes book and the register of members shall be kept open for inspection by the members of the trust, free of charge during the business hours of the Trust.

The provisions of the Societies Registration Act, 1975 shall apply
far as they are not expressly stated herein this byelaws.
