- ▶ DBT Star College Scheme was awarded for five Departments (Biochemistry, Biotechnology, Computer science, Mathematics and Physics) with a financial grant of Rs. 1.04 crores
- MoU is signed with St.Joseph College of Commerce (Autonomous), Bengaluru and Shri Ramakrishna Mission Vidhyalaya College of Arts and Science(Autonomous), Coimbatore
- > 80 research articles are published by the faculty members with impact factors
- > 7 faculty members have published Books
- > 13 M.Phil. scholars and 2 Ph.D. scholars were awarded Degree
- NSS camp was conducted at Govt. Higher Secondary School and a roof of worth Rs. 2,00,000/was erected

- Rs. 38,00,000 spent to enrich learning resources

- Rare collection of books are available in the Library
