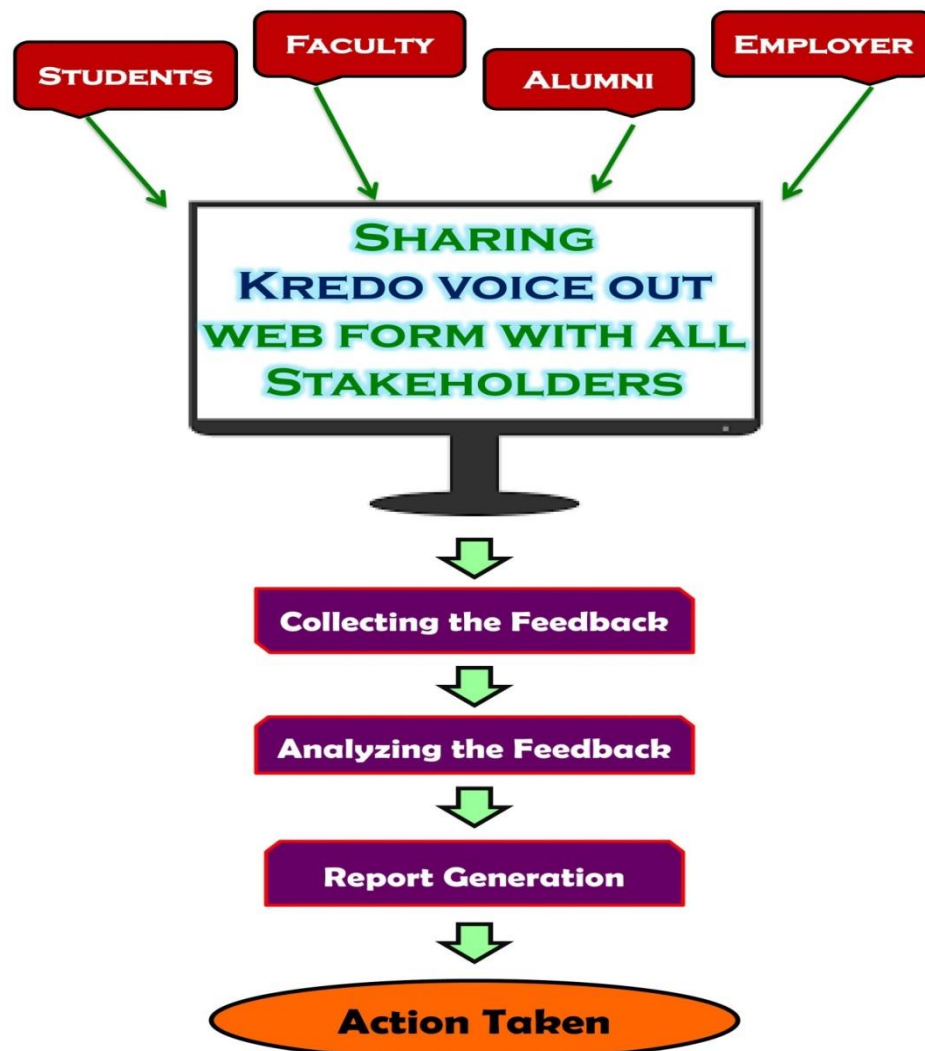
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FEEDBACK MECHANISM

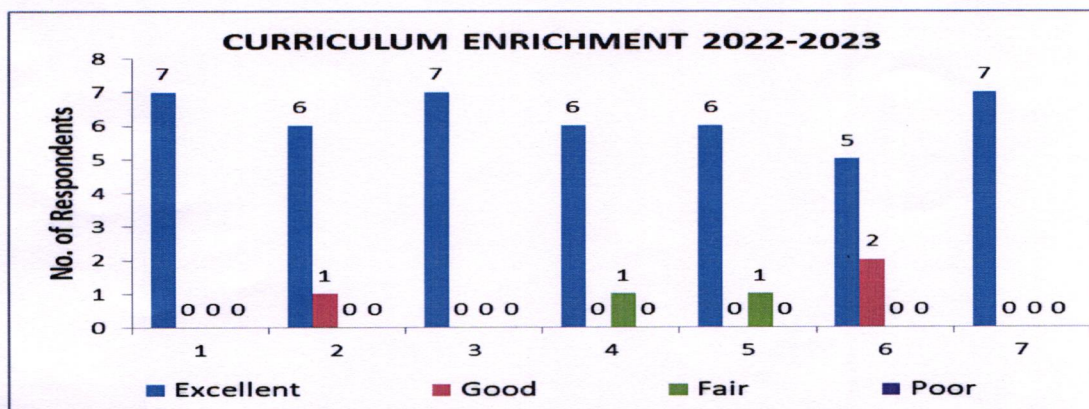
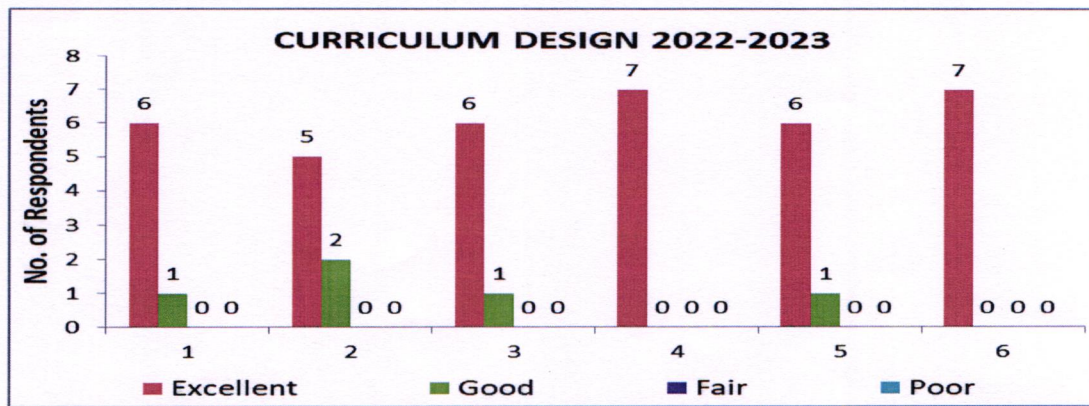
The Under Graduate and Post Graduate students provided feedback regarding the curriculum. The feedback is signified graphically in the Figure below.

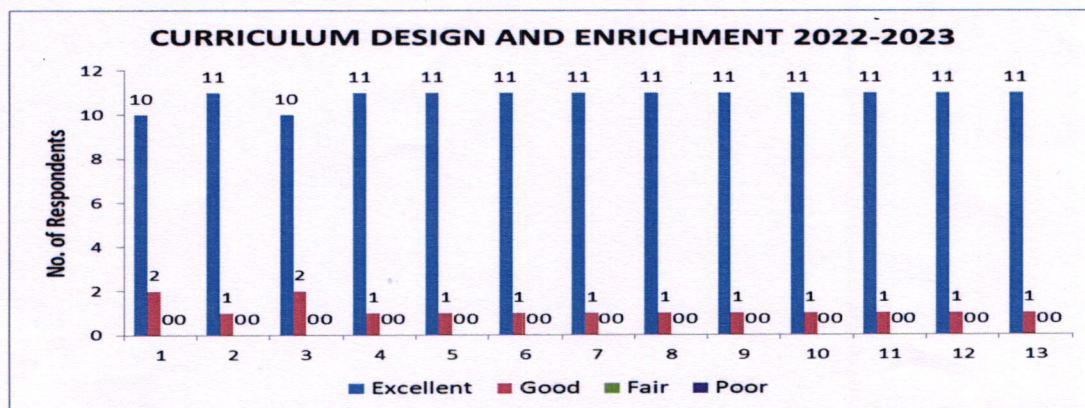
- Feedback of M.A English Literature

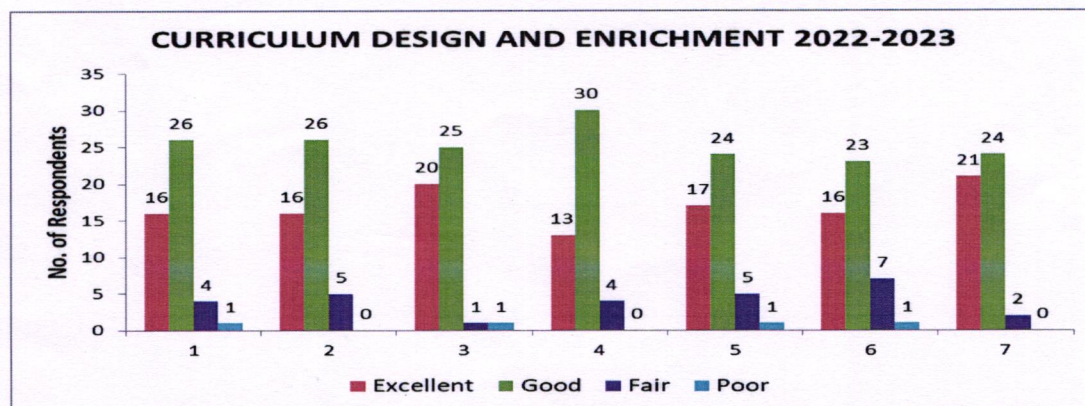

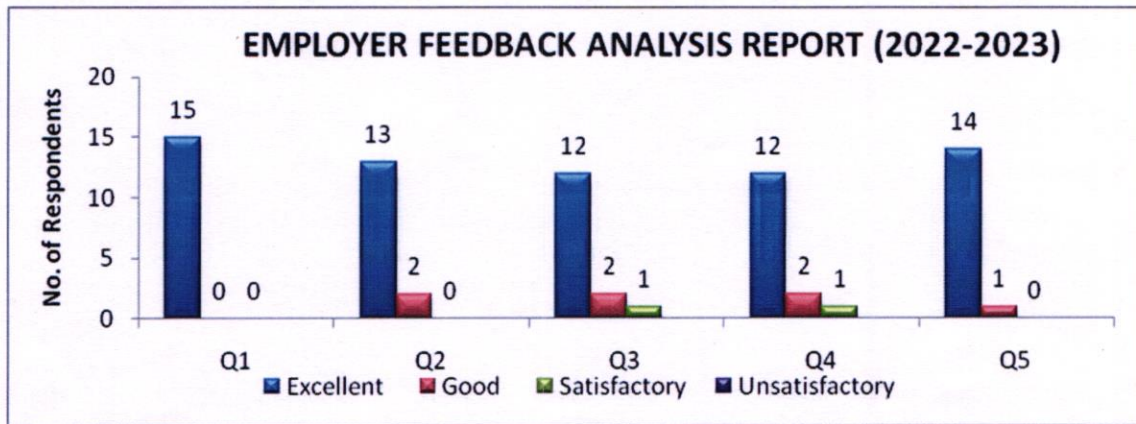

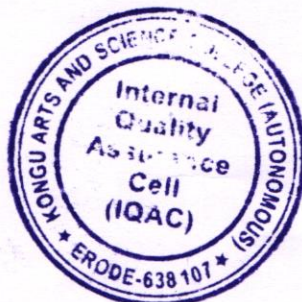
The present Curriculum Design and syllabi of the various courses created by the Department of English have received an average rating of "Excellent" from 87% of employers and "Good" from 13%

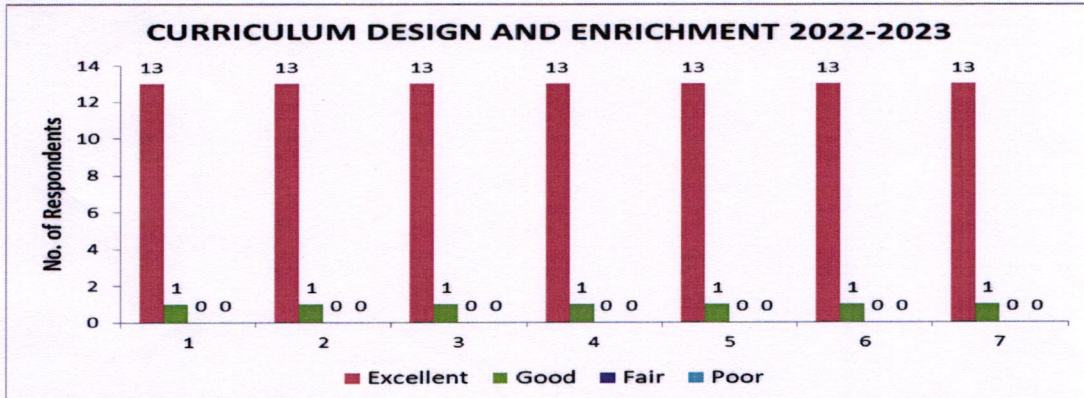
The graph that follows demonstrates the faculty members' assessments of the departments' curricula.

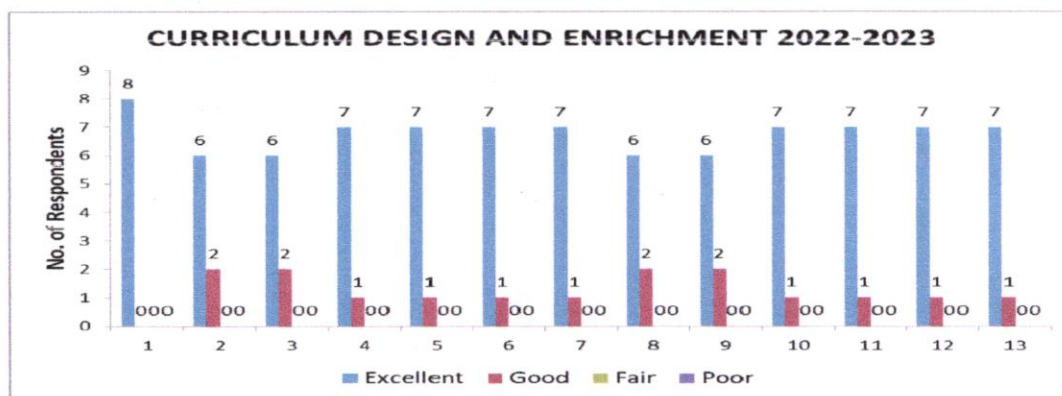

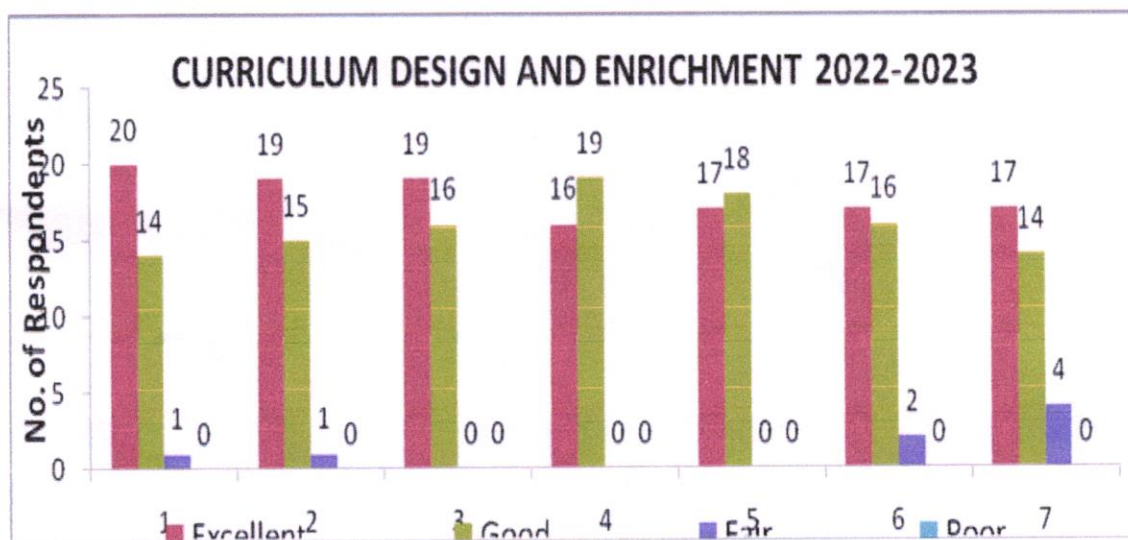

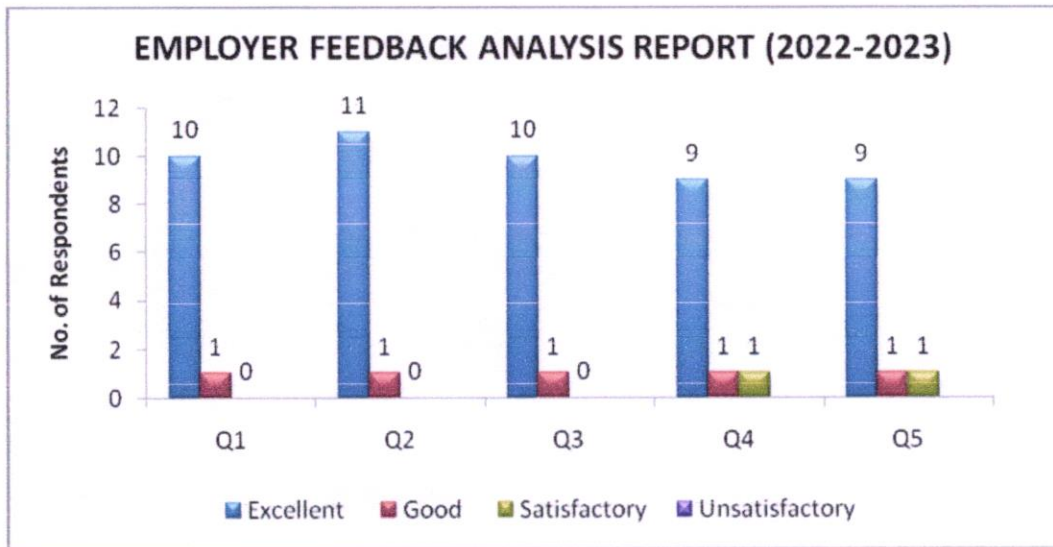

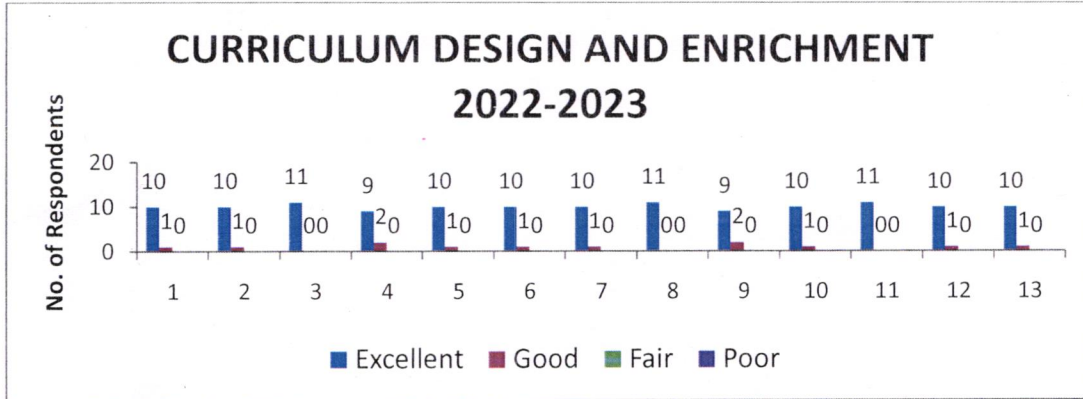
