An average of 66% Students have consented the syllabus as 'Excellent', 34% have rated it as 'Good' about the current syllabus designed by the Department of English


The Post Graduate students provided feedback which is indicated graphically regarding the curriculum in the figure below.


















The Post Graduate students provided feedback which is indicated graphically regarding the curriculum in the figure below.






