The following resolutions were passed in the meeting.

- 1) Circular will be sent to all the students to prohibit Ragging.
- 2) Regular interaction and counseling for students will be done to establish a cordial relationship among the senior students and junior students.
- 3) Separate Register to maintain the complaints on ragging & action taken.
- 4) Random checking in college buses has to be done and a meeting with all the bus drivers will be conducted in this regard.
- 5) Surprise inspection of hostels, canteen, toilets and bus stop will be done.
- 6) To eliminate the unwanted fear about ragging among the first year students, constitution of Anti-Ragging Committee comprising of both the faculty members for the academic year 2018-19 will be formed.
- 7) Regular checking through CCTV Cameras which are installed at vital points inside the campus.
- 8) Separate floor for the fresh students in both the hostels will be provided.
- 9) Contact number of CURB committee chairman should be printed in the Identity Card of the First Year Students.
- 10) Videos on Ragging (downloaded from the UGC Website) will be screened to counsel the II and III year UG students on ill effects of ragging in the month of June, 2018 before the commencement of classes for the I year UG students.
- 11) As per the letter dated 25.05.2018 from UGC, the following actions will be taken:
 - a) Anti-Ragging Squad comprising of senior students including NSS Volunteers and NCC Cadets for the academic year 2018-19 will be formed.
 - b) Undertaking by the students and parents as per the 2nd Amendment in the UGC Regulations will be made online.
 - c) Necessary steps to increase the number of CCTV cameras at vital points.
