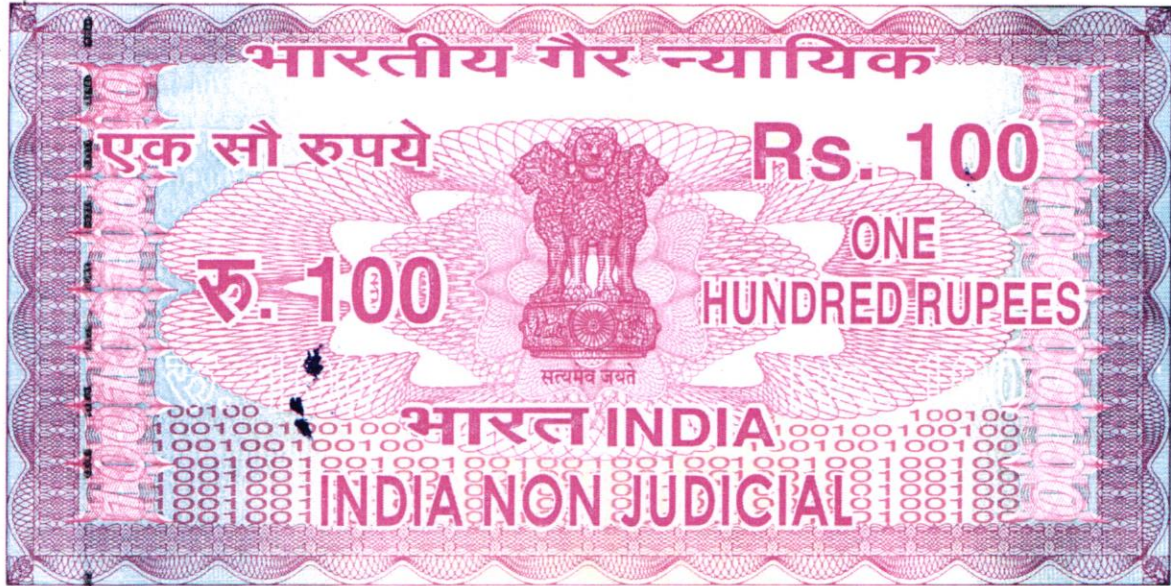

The scope of MoU includes the following aspects:

- Research Summer internship/Projects Awareness Programmes for Faculty, scholars and students without any financial implications on both sides
- Facilitate project oriented Industry – Institute Interface
- KASC to be Institutional channel partner of Avinashilingam Institute for community development such as guiding rural women in research and skill development and provide technology through specialized support centers
- Participation in Value Added Courses and Life Skill Development courses to be organized for the researchers, Supervisors, Scholars, Faculty members and students

Whereas the objectives of AIHEW are

- To provide student graduates a strong foundation in AI required for better living with an interdisciplinary approach
- To prepare the graduates to identify and analyze challenges in life and career
- To give students project-based education with innovative technologies and ICT tools so as to enable them to easily adapt to new environments and emerging trends
- To inculcate humanitarian concerns and ethics in students integrated with capacity building skills to apply the acquired knowledge for the environment, society and under-privileged community

Joint activities:

The cooperation may concern any area in Science and Technology. This will include the various activities as mentioned below:

Faculty members

It is agreed to strengthen the relation between both the Institutions in contributing to education, research and/or training with upgradation of technology. The objective is to share and exchange technical knowledge/information, support each other in the conduct of their respective ongoing activities and develop innovative methods that can be applied to enhance academic and/or research processes. The timing, financials and other details relating to the interaction shall be mutually decided and acceptable to both parties.

Students project work, internships and training

It is mutually agreed that AIHEW and KASC students, based on certain selection criteria shall be allowed to carry out research work, internship or training as an exchange activity with a mentor assigned by the organizers. The duration, nature of task and other details relating to the project work, internship or training shall be mutually decided and acceptable by both parties.

Short term training

Whenever one of the parties organizes a training programme, both parties agree for considerable opportunities and benefits will be provided by the party offering training, to the other party. On a need basis, one party shall offer customized training programmes exclusively for the other party. The details of the training, financials involved shall be mutually decided and acceptable by both parties.

Knowledge sharing

Both parties agree to share information and knowledge in such a way that both of them shall jointly work towards

- using each other's books, magazines, publications and other sharable information and publications as and when required, by following the respective prevailing procedures for borrowing or sharing.
- content creation and obtaining resource materials for educational purposes or industry processes
- offering training and development of technical manpower, creating public awareness on environment friendly activities, etc., in the areas acceptable to both parties for the sake of the society
- to facilitate research activities
- apply for funding projects for various approved agencies
- Research paper, articles and book chapters publications

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Scope of MoU

- Both the Institutes are pleased to enter into memorandum of understanding and strongly believe that this understanding will lead to a meaningful interaction, cooperation, collaboration and sharing of knowledge and expertise, which will not only be mutually beneficial, but also benefit the society and ultimately the Nation
- Both parties will value the spirit of this MoU and work towards strengthening and developing the various clauses of this MoU
- This MoU shall be extended for such period and for such further understanding as may be deemed necessary from time to time
- Draw the attention of the top management in case of any interference of operational problems

AIHEW's contribution

1. KASC shall be given access to AIHEW library for borrowing and referring books / magazines etc., on returnable basis
2. Students and academicians from AIHEW shall contribute their knowledge and expertise whenever KASC conducts educational and research programs (seminar or workshop) for the industry and institution as speaker.
3. Teaching members should regulate their students for an obedient and disciplined participation
4. Conduct of seminars, workshops and training programmes to inculcate research spirit among the faculty members and researchers

KASC's contribution

1. KASC shall invite Faculty members and students of AIHEW for the events relating to Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs)
2. KASC shall accommodate for Faculty and Student Exchange Programmes on mutually agreed dates.
3. Specialized support centres of KASC shall act as knowledge partners of AIHEW on specific assignments.

Arbitration and Jurisdiction

- Both parties agree that provisions content in this MoU do not create any legal obligations between the parties
- In the event of any misunderstanding and differences between the parties hereto, such misunderstanding/differences shall be solved amicably by mutual discussions
- Both parties agree that the dispute not solved amicably shall be submitted exclusively to a Sole Arbitrator appointed by the Vice Chancellor of the Party of the First Part. The provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 will apply and the Venue of Arbitration will be at Coimbatore and a court for the purpose of jurisdiction is Coimbatore Courts only. The resulting award by the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on both parties
