It is my privilege to present the 24th Annual Report of our College. At present, our College offers 19 UG, 9 PG, 45 Value Added Programmes, 1 UGC sponsored Add on Programmes and 2 Professional Coaching Classes for the Chartered Accountant and Associate Company Secretaryship. Research Programmes are also offered (M.Phil. and Ph.D.).

The total students' strength of our College is 4701 with 2451 Boys and 2250 Girls. There are 190 teaching and 118 non-teaching staff in our College.
