


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Subject related to CBCS, Outcome based Syllabus, Advanced Learners Course, Extra credits and Non Major Electives were discussed and the following are the resolutions:

- It is resolved to approve the additional name for Panel of Members for Question Paper Setting and Central Valuation. (Annexure –II)






Details of modifications in the courses offered under the programme BBA
