- To consider and approve the continuity of CBCS pattern and Outcome Based Education for all UG and PG Programmes.
- To consider and approve the continuity of Credit System, Grade Point Average (GPA),
 Weighted Average Marks (WAM) and Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) at the time of issuing Consolidated Statement of Marks.
- To consider and approve the Feedback on curriculum design and enrichment obtained from Students, Faculty members, Alumni, and Employers for the academic year 2024-2025.
- It is resolved to approve the continuation of the Part I course: Tamil / Other languages and Part II course: English of III and IV Semesters for the UG students admitted during the academic year 2023-2024 and onwards.
