


65% IT leaders surveyed prioritise cybersecurity, followed by cloud and AI/ML


Of the 37 technology executives who participated in the Deloitte survey, 65 per cent of the respondents claimed cybersecurity to be a priority in terms of preferred technology, followed by cloud computing at 62 per cent and AI/ML at 54 per cent, stated the company's Sprint to Excellence report.

The report said cybersecurity was expected to be the top priority due to the growing reliance on technology. The survey highlighted a rising focus on cybersecurity measures within organisations and across sectors, as they store sensitive data in the cloud and use interconnected systems.

Deepa Seshadri, Partner, and CIO Program Leader, Deloitte India, told *businessline*, "To understand our clients' priorities, we conversed with them while considering that digital transformation has been a priority. From a digital standpoint, there has been growth, but we wanted to see where the focus for these organisations lies in the current 12-18 months timeframe and the next three years. Most respondents see investing in technology as a way to grow because technology has evolved into a business issue." She added that these respondents were some of Deloitte's Fortune 500 clients.

Responses were collected to understand how the technology stack is evolving, changing business models, and required leadership skills.


OpenAI introduces credit-based costs for 'ChatGPT Enterprise', ending fixed pricing:

OpenAI has reportedly changed the way it charges businesses for ChatGPT Enterprise. Instead of a fixed monthly or yearly subscription, companies will now buy credits to use advanced features and tools, reports the Wall Street Journal. The new credit system will work like a pay-as-you-go model. In simple terms, under this new model, enterprise customers no longer pay a flat fee. Instead, they purchase usage credits that can be applied toward accessing premium capabilities. This approach allows businesses to scale their spending based on actual demand. Notably, the exact pricing for ChatGPT Enterprise is not publicly disclosed.

Exclusive: Google makes new proposal to stave off EU antitrust fine, document shows

BRUSSELS, July 2 (Reuters) - Google (GOOGL.O), opens new tab has proposed fresh changes to its search results in an attempt to fend off growing criticism from rivals, a week before a key meeting that could lead to yet another EU antitrust fine, according to a document seen by Reuters.


The U.S. tech giant has been under pressure after being hit in March with European Union antitrust charges of unfairly favouring its own services such as Google Shopping, Google Hotels and Google Flights over competitors.

The company, owned by Alphabet, will meet its rivals and the European Commission to discuss its proposals during a July 7-8 workshop in Brussels, the document said.

The EU's landmark Digital Markets Act, under which Google has been charged, sets out a list of dos and don'ts for Big Tech aimed at curbing their power and giving rivals more room to compete and consumers more choice.







HCLTech eyes new revenue streams to diversify risks

Billionaire Shiv Nadar-founded IT services firm HCLTech is looking to diversify risks and unlock new revenue streams, by expanding its presence in markets such as India, Africa and the Middle East.

HCLTech outlined its growth strategies to more than 100 analysts who attended an 'Investor Day 2024' meet hosted by the company in Mumbai on Wednesday. The company also highlighted its strength in engineering, research & development (ER&D), and plans to leverage increasing semiconductor demand, expand market participation in focus areas and new frontier markets, and grow within its top current and potential clients, some of the analysts who attended the event said.

"The company wants to tap high-potential regions and expand, amid the ongoing slowdown in the core American markets denting business over the past five-six quarters," one of the analysts said on the condition of anonymity. "HCLTech spoke of improving the mix of verticals and geographies, gaining of market share, organic development of digital skills, its clients' cloud migration activities and inorganic augmentation of capabilities."

The management showcased its chip-to-cloud offerings and growth areas of financial services; telecom, media & entertainment (TMT); and automotive sectors, alongside capabilities around artificial intelligence, data and cybersecurity to compete with larger rivals Tata Consultancy Services and Infosys. It has set up an AI research team besides its AI and generative AI offerings — AI foundry, AI force and AI labs — and plans to train around 50,000 people in GenAI.




Exclusive: Intel's new CEO explores big shift in chip manufacturing business

Since taking in March, CEO Lip-Bu Tan has moved fast to cut costs and find a new path to revive the ailing U.S. chipmaker. By June, he started voicing that a manufacturing process that prior CEO Pat Gelsinger bet heavily on, known as 18A, was losing its appeal to new customers, said the sources, who spoke on condition of anonymity.

To put aside external sales of 18A and its variant 18A-P, manufacturing processes that have cost Intel billions of dollars to develop, the company would have to take a write-off, one of the people familiar with the matter said. Industry analysts contacted by Reuters said such a charge could amount to a loss of hundreds of millions, if not billions, of dollars.

The IT industry has raised concerns with the Indian government around Singapore's new framework for skilled worker visas, saying it could hinder ease of doing business due to the existing skills shortage. Google makes new proposal to stave off EU antitrust fine, document shows

Google has proposed fresh changes to its search results in an attempt to fend off growing criticism from rivals, according to a document seen by Reuters. The company, owned by Alphabet, will meet its rivals and the European Commission to discuss its proposals during a July 7-8 workshop in Brussels, the document said. Last week, Google offered to create a box at the top of the search page for a so-called vertical search service (VSS) which would contain links to specialised search engines as well as to hotels, airlines, restaurants and transport services. The latest offer, called Option B, is an alternative to last week's proposal, according to a Google document sent by the Commission to involved parties and seen by Reuters






Cognizant to create 8,000 jobs with Rs 1,583 crore IT campus in Visakhapatnam

The IT company, Cognizant, is set to establish a world-class IT and ITES campus in Visakhapatnam at an investment of Rs 1,583 crore to generate 8,000 jobs in the next few years, ruling TDP party said.

The state government will allot land to Cognizant at the nominal rate of Rs 99 paisa, said the press release.

"In a major boost to Andhra Pradesh's IT ecosystem, Cognizant Technology Solutions is all set to establish a world-class IT/ITES campus in Visakhapatnam with an investment of Rs 1,582.98 crore," said the press release.

Incidentally, Cognizant sought 21.31 acres of land at Kapulauppada under the Visakhapatnam Metropolitan Region Development Authority (VMRDA) for the new IT campus.



Apple reduces iPhone prices in India, here are all the new prices


iPhone sales fell on account of a sales decline in its Greater **China region**, which includes Mainland China, Taiwan, Singapore, and Hong Kong, where sales slid 8% year-on-year, due to strong competition from Huawei, according to analysts. Apple chief financial officer, Luca Maestri added that the company also set a six-month revenue record in India, among other **emerging markets**. "We were particularly pleased with our strong momentum in emerging markets, as we set first-half revenue records in several countries and regions including Latin America, the Middle East, India, Indonesia, the Philippines, and Turkey," Maestri said. Cook said that Apple is producing iPhone in India to stay competitive, and the company's growth in the India market is linked to its operational expansion. "From a pragmatic point of view, you need to produce there to be competitive, and so, yes, the two things are linked from that point of view, but we have both operational things going on and we have go to market and initiatives going on," the executive said. He said Apple sees enormous opportunities from the India market, after opening two stores last year. Apple continues to expand its channels and is also working with the developer ecosystem, resulting in a rapid growth in the base of developers.



WazirX faces flak over handling of \$230-million crypto heist

Synopsis

Cryptocurrency platform WazirX suffered the biggest cyberattack on an Indian exchange, with hackers stealing more than \$230 million worth of investor holdings, or nearly half of the platform's estimated reserves.

Students seek clarity as Infosys offers two pre-training rounds

Infosys has asked about 1,500 students from the April 2022 batch having offer letters to appear for two rounds of pre-training. Of the total, India's second-largest software services company has given September 2 as the joining date to only about 115 students, while the rest remain in a state of flux about their job prospects.

Hiring worries at Infosys underscore a broader squeeze in recruitment in the technology sector due to factors such as economic uncertainties and increasing automation. Indian IT firms are under pressure from students, public outcry and worker unions over the onboarding delays.

In July, Infosys had called all the selected students for a mandatory virtual pre-training programme for 24 days. Following this, another self-learning module-based pre-training was organised for some students in August which resulted in joining dates allotted to the 115 students. For the remaining students, there is limited clarity on the assessment and confusion of login credentials to some students for the second pre-training round. There have been no rejection letters yet, multiple people in ..

Earlier this month, students received an email from Infosys' recruitment team for a second six-week virtual pre-training starting August 19, which included a self-learning module, followed by an in-person assessment across cities. Further, those who clear the competency tests would be invited to join an in-person immersive training programme.

Beyond ChatGPT: Shadow AI Risks Lurk in SaaS Tools

Unapproved use of ChatGPT and other generative AI tools is creating a growing cybersecurity blind spot for businesses. As employees adopt these technologies without proper oversight, they may inadvertently expose sensitive data — yet many managers still underestimate the risk and delay implementing third-party defenses.


This type of unsanctioned technology use, known as shadow IT, has long posed security challenges. Now, its AI-driven counterpart — shadow AI — is triggering new concerns among cybersecurity experts.

Melissa Ruzzi, director of AI at SaaS security firm AppOmni, says AI can analyze and extract far more information from data, making it more dangerous than traditional shadow IT.

“In most cases, broader access to data is given to AI compared to shadow IT so that AI can perform its tasks. This increases the potential exposure in the case of a data breach,” she told TechNewsWorld.







Why IT needs framework for responsible agentic AI

The IT industry needs to come up with standards and frameworks for the responsible deployment of agentic artificial intelligence, as this technology can carry out tasks autonomously with minimal human oversight, experts and senior executives of companies such as Infosys and Tech Mahindra told ET.

PROMPT ENGINEERS WANTED TECH COMPANIES HUNT FOR PEOPLE WHO SPEAK THE AI LANGUAGE :

- The demand for AI prompt engineers has gone up by 300% on a year-on-year basis. This comes on the back of rapid adoption of generative AI technologies such as ChatGPT, DALL-E, and other large language models (LLMs)," said Jaideep Kewalramani, COO at TeamLease Edtech. In the last six months alone, 18,000-22,000 new roles were created in the segment according to hiring firm TeamLease. Typically, college graduates with basic English language proficiency are bagging entry level jobs, while engineers with AI and machine learning certification can demand compensation of around Rs 20 lakh annually, recruiters said. At the entry level, prompt engineers could be paid around Rs 4 lakh per annum, they added.

Of the 37 technology executives who participated in the Deloitte survey, 65 per cent of the respondents claimed cybersecurity to be a priority in terms of preferred technology, followed by cloud computing at 62 per cent and AI/ML at 54 per cent, stated the company's Sprint to Excellence report.

The report said cybersecurity was expected to be the top priority due to the growing reliance on technology. The survey highlighted a rising focus on cybersecurity measures within organisations and across sectors, as they store sensitive data in the cloud and use interconnected systems.

Deepa Seshadri, Partner, and CIO Program Leader, Deloitte India, told businessline, "To understand our clients' priorities, we conversed with them while considering that digital transformation has been a priority. From a digital standpoint, there has been growth, but we wanted to see where the focus for these organisations lies in the current 12-18 months timeframe and the next three years. Most respondents see investing in technology as a way to grow because technology has evolved into a business issue." She added that these respondents were some of Deloitte's Fortune 500 clients.

Responses were collected to understand how the technology stack is evolving, changing business models, and required leadership skills.

IT flags Singapore's new skilled visa framework

The industry has flagged the narrow criteria under the points-based framework, where only eight Indian universities are eligible for points and all nationalities are given equal weightage for diversity assessment, which may not reflect the on-ground realities, industry body Nasscom told ET. 




HCLTech, Wipro see discretionary spends uptick in BFSI sector


Students seek clarity as Infosys offers two pre-training rounds

Infosys has asked about 1,500 students from the April 2022 batch having offer letters to appear for two rounds of pre-training. Of the total, India's second-largest software services company has given September 2 as the joining date to only about 115 students, while the rest remain in a state of flux about their job prospects.

Hiring worries at Infosys underscore a broader squeeze in recruitment in the technology sector due to factors such as economic uncertainties and increasing automation. Indian IT firms are under pressure from students, public outcry and worker unions over the onboarding delays.

In July, Infosys had called all the selected students for a mandatory virtual pre-training programme for 24 days. Following this, another self-learning module-based pre-training was organised for some students in August which resulted in joining dates allotted to the 115 students. For the remaining students, there is limited clarity on the assessment and confusion of login credentials to some students for the second pre-training round. There have been no rejection letters yet, multiple people in ..


Earlier this month, students received an email from Infosys' recruitment team for a second six-week virtual pre-training starting August 19, which included a self-learning module, followed by an in-person assessment across cities. Further, those who clear the competency tests would be invited to join an in-person immersive training programme.

Nvidia Corp, the world's biggest chipmaker, has discussed joining a funding round for Open AI that would value the artificial intelligence startup at more than \$100 billion, according to people familiar with the matter.

Apple Inc and Microsoft Corp also have been in talks about participating in the financing, said the people, who asked not to be identified because the deliberations are private. The round would be led by Thrive Capital, which is investing about \$1 billion, Bloomberg reported earlier this week. Nvidia has discussed investing about \$100 million, two of the people said. If the discussions move forward, it would mean the three most valuable tech companies are all backing Open AI, maker of the groundbreaking Chat GPT chatbot. Microsoft was already Open AI's biggest funder, having invested roughly \$13 billion. Representatives for Nvidia, Apple, Microsoft, OpenAI and Thrive all declined to comment. Nvidia, meanwhile, supplies the critical infrastructure needed to develop and run AI tools like Chat GPT. It's the biggest maker of so-called AI accelerators, sales of which have soared over the past two years.



- The attrition rate for the quarter under review stood at 12.8%, against 13% in the March quarter and 13.2% in the December quarter.



TCS extends partnership, to transform Primark's tech ops in 5 years



The company's profit dropped 9.73% to Rs 3,843 crore compared to the same quarter last year. However, its revenue from operations increased by 8.17% to Rs 30,349 crore.

In terms of revenue growth, HCLTech reported a 3.7% year-over-year (YoY) growth in constant currency (CC), with its services business growing 4.5% YoY in CC. The company also won new deals worth \$1.8 billion in the quarter.

HCLTech's CEO, C Vijayakumar, stated that the company's AI offerings are gaining traction with clients, and its partnership with OpenAI will further enhance its AI capabilities.


65% IT leaders surveyed prioritise cybersecurity, followed by cloud and AI/ML

Of the 37 technology executives who participated in the Deloitte survey, 65 per cent of the respondents claimed cybersecurity to be a priority in terms of preferred technology, followed by cloud computing at 62 per cent and AI/ML at 54 per cent, stated the company's Sprint to Excellence report.

The report said cybersecurity was expected to be the top priority due to the growing reliance on technology. The survey highlighted a rising focus on cybersecurity measures within organisations and across sectors, as they store sensitive data in the cloud and use interconnected systems.

Deepa Seshadri, Partner, and CIO Program Leader, Deloitte India, told businessline, "To understand our clients' priorities, we conversed with them while considering that digital transformation has been a priority. From a digital standpoint, there has been growth, but we wanted to see where the focus for these organisations lies in the current 12-18 months timeframe and the next three years. Most respondents see investing in technology as a way to grow because technology has evolved into a business issue." She added that these respondents were some of Deloitte's Fortune 500 clients.



Ex-Open AI researcher to start new company focused on AI teaching assistants

The new venture launched by a founding member of OpenAI could potentially compete with the likes of Khan Academy. Andrej Karpathy, an OpenAI cofounder and former Tesla executive, said that he is starting his own AI education company that would focus on developing personalised AI teaching assistants for students on-demand. The company is called Eureka Labs and is based out of San Francisco.

It was registered as an LLC in Delaware, US, according to a report by TechCrunch. Based on Karpathy's post on X, it appears that Eureka Labs will build AI teaching assistants that will work together with human teachers. "The teacher still designs the course materials, but they are supported, leveraged and scaled with an AI Teaching Assistant who is optimized to help guide the students through them.

"This Teacher + AI symbiosis could run an entire curriculum of courses on a common platform," Karpathy said. However, before it is able to ship AI teaching assistants to classrooms, Eureka Labs is looking to launch its first product called LLM101n. It is an undergraduate course for those interested to learn about training their own AI models and will reportedly be a small-scale version of what Eureka Labs aims to do.







HCLTech, Wipro see discretionary spends uptick in BFSI sector

Two of the top four Indian IT companies, HCL Tech and Wipro, are seeing an uptick in discretionary spend in banking, financial services and insurance (BFSI) compared to a few months ago, a pleasant surprise for the IT industry. HCLTech told analysts last week about the uptick in discretionary spending in BFSI, even as its other verticals continued to be driven by cost takeout deals.

During the April-June quarter Wipro also saw a spurt in its Capco consulting, which mainly focuses on BFSI clients and discretionary spends.

Experts hope the revival of discretionary spending would become widespread in the next two quarters, as they expect a rate cut to happen soon. Clients have already hired consultants to discuss next year's budget and take a call on discretionary spending, analysts told ET.

HSBC Global Research said in a note on HCLTech last week, "There has been some uptick in discretionary spends within banking customers compared to a few months back. Most other verticals are status quo and the demand there is still driven by cost optimisation deals."

"As part of our bold and responsible approach to AI, we've proactively engaged with experts, policymakers and privacy regulators on this expansion," Krawczyk wrote. "As we bring Bard to more regions and languages over time, we'll continue to use our AI Principles as a guide, incorporate user feedback and take steps to protect people's privacy and data." The link to the privacy and data protection guidelines details information including the length of time Bard stores user information, how users can change that timeframe, and the type of information it stores.

Quantum Computing upstart QpiAI gets India Government backing in its \$32Mn Series A fundraise

Bengaluru-headquartered QpiAI, a headstarter in India's nascent Quantum computing space, has secured a total of \$32 Million in a Series A fundraise, which includes backing by the Indian Government. The round was led by Avataar Ventures and the National Quantum Mission (NQM), a \$750Mn initiative by the Indian government to provide thrust to India's quantum computing companies. The round also drew contributions from an unlisted group of both returning and new investors. This latest capital infusion places QpiAI's post-money valuation at \$162 million.

QpiAI's ambitious development schedule includes the introduction of a 64-qubit quantum machine by the end of the coming year, with client access projected for the second or third quarter of 2027.




Genpact spending millions to create AI solutions: CEO
